Vintage

Lot sorted, small batch, temperature controlled fermentation. Expertly blended before gentle bottling

Aging

18 months in 100% French oak. 20% new. 20% one year, and 60% 2 year old or neutral barrels. 18 months in bottle

Tasting Notes

To the eye the wine presents a bright ruby hue with luminous highlights. the bouquet is composted of violets, with fruit notes from strawberry's and rhubarb while there is an undertone of subtle spice. Unusually bright with fantastic texture it lines the pallet with silk and lace. Pleasing tart cherry, a hint of pie spice, and dusty tannins lead to a long complex finish.
